The contractor already registered on the e-tendering portal will have option to continue by paying tender processing fee up to one year from the date of registration, or to switch over to (new) registration without tender processing fee any time. All new registrations from 01.04.2015 will be without tender processing fee.
2. (i) It is mandatory to upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid documents. If the documents stipulated in the bid document are not uploaded, then bid will become invalid and shall summarily be rejected.  
  
(ii) The bid submitted shall become invalid if: The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.

3. Copy of enlistment order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the tender documents for eligibility shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded document as specified in tender documents shall be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority failing which the bid shall be rejected. He/they shall be debarred from further bidding in CPWD.
4. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.
5. The bid submitted shall be opened at 15:30 hrs. on 30.10.2020 The Technical bid/eligibility document shall be opened first on due date and time as mentioned above. The financial bid of only those contractors will be opened who qualify the eligibility criteria given in the eligibility bid document and shortlisted after evaluation as given in Para 8 of the Eligibility bid Document. The date and time of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the eligibility bid shall be communicated to them at later date.
6. Financial bid of only those eligible contractors will be opened who qualify the eligible criteria given in Part I of Tender Document (i.e. Eligibility Document) and shortlisted after evaluation as given in the Eligibility Document. If any discrepancy are noticed in the documents submitted by the agency including the work experience certificate, the same shall be got clarified from the agency / client failing which the pre-qualification /bid of the agency shall be rejected.
7. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:-
  - i. GST registration Certificate of the State in which the work is to be taken up, if already obtained by the bidder. If the bidder has not obtained GST registration in the State in which the work is to be taken up or as required by GST authorities then in such a case the bidder shall scan and upload following under taking along with other bid documents. "If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration Certificate of the State, in which work is to be taken up, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by CPWD, whichever is earlier, failing which I/We shall be responsible for any delay in payments which will be due towards me/us on a/c of the work executed and/or for any action taken by CPWD or GST department in this regard.
  - ii. If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of tender opening authority.
  - iii. The bidder does not deposit the original EMD in the office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission.

- iv. If a tenderer quotes Nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
8. If any discrepancy is noticed in the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and those verified by Executive Engineer, Border Fencing Division-V, CPWD, 79th BN, BSF Campus, Mundra road, Bhuj- 370001 (Gujarat) from the individuals, employers, firms and corporation etc the department may not only reject the bid but also take action to withdraw the enlistment and debar the bidder from tendering in CPWD”.
9. The contractor, whose bid is finally accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in schedule-F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.10,000/-) or Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/Pay order of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in schedule 'F' including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with tenders shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee.
10. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
11. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or

all the bids received without assigning any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.

12. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
13. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable license/ registration or proof for applying for obtaining labour license, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW welfare board and programme chart (time and progress within the period specified in Schedule 'F').
14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
16. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who has not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
17. The list of document to be scanned and uploaded within the period of bid submission. **CPWD registered contractor of appropriate class and category are not required to submit / upload the documents as listed at serial no.(d), (f), (g), (i) and (k) as mentioned below:-**
  - a) Treasury challan/demand draft /pay order or banker's cheque/deposit at call receipt /FDR/Bank Guarantee of any schedule bank against EMD.
  - b) Enlistment order of the contractor, if any.



- c) Copy of Receipt of deposition of original EMD issued from division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE), CPWD (Form – F).
- d) Work experience certificate showing experience in eligible similar work (Form – “C” “C-1”& “D”) as defined in CPWD -6.
- e) Certificate of Registration of GST and acknowledgement of up to date filed return i.e. upto **31.12.2019**. If the bidder has not obtained GST registration in the state in which the work is to be taken up, then in such a case the bidder shall upload following undertaking with the bid document “if work is awarded to me, I/We shall obtain GST registration certificate within one month from date of receipt of award letter or before payment of 1st R.A. Bill”.

18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **Seventy five (75) days** from the date of opening of eligibility bids.

(i) If any bidder withdraws his bid or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days **after last date of submission of bids**, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely **irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not**.

(ii) If any bidder withdraws his bid or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the bid which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days **after last date of submission of bids**, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

(iii) **In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above**, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.

19. This notice inviting tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

- (a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, special conditions specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of

submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading there to.

(b) C.P.W.D. General Condition Contract 2020 for construction work with correction slips issued up to last date of submission of bid.

(c) Minutes of Pre bid Conference.

20. GST, Turnover Tax, statutory charges, duties, Construction Worker's Welfare Cess, Education Cess, etc. shall be payable by the contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same.

21. As applicable in the present bid

21.1 The Executive Engineer of the major component will be Engineer in charge of the work and will call bids for the work. The Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the estimated cost put to bid for the work.

21.2 The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items.

21.3 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the Executive Engineer in charge of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's / ~~DDH~~ in charge of minor component. One such signed set of agreement shall be handed over to EE/~~DDH~~ in charge of minor component. EE in charge of major component will operate part A and part B of the agreement. EE/~~DDH~~ in charge of minor component (s) shall operate Part C along with Part A of the agreement.

21.4 Entire work under the scope of bid shall be executed under one agreement.

21.5 Security Deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the tendered cost of the respective component of works.

21.6 The main contractor has to associate agency(s) for minor component (s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s).

21.7 In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency / agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of minor component. The new agency/ agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer-in-charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.

21.8 The main contractor has to enter into agreement with the contractor (s) associated by him for execution of minor component(s). Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE/~~DDH~~ in charge of each minor component as well as to EE in

charge of major component. In case of change of associate contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.

- 21.9 Running payment for the major component shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.
- 21.10 The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the works are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer-in-charge of major component after record of completion certificate of all other components.
- 21.11 Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the EE of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the EE of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract.
- 21.12 In case of any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of the bid online and hard copies as submitted physically in the office of Executive Engineer, then the bid submitted shall become invalid and the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.
22. All compensations or the other sums of money payable by the contractor under the terms of this contract may be deducted from, or paid by the sale of a sufficient part of his security deposit or from the interest arising there from, or from any sums which may be due to or may become due to the contractor by Government on any account whatsoever and in the event of his Security Deposit being reduced by reason of any such deductions or sale as aforesaid, the contractor shall within 10 days make good in cash or fixed deposit receipt tendered by the State Bank of India or by Scheduled Bank or Government Securities (if deposited for more than 12 months) endorsed in favour of the Engineer-in-Charge, any sum or sums which may have been deducted from, or raised by sale of his security deposit or any part thereof. The security deposit shall be collected from the running bills of the contractor at the rates mentioned above.

2. The site of the Project is located in the Great Rann of Kachchh near the India-Pakistan border. The Rann of Kachchh is a seasonally marshy region situated south of the Thar desert. Although Rann is almost a plain area, many depressions of varying dimensions are also observed. These depressions get filled up with rain water during monsoon.
3. **Contractor has to ply on desert land itself for carrying materials /machineries to BP 1142 to BP 1159 site. Road connectivity is available upto BP-1135. The intending contractors shall see the site physically and assess the cost involved in making the temporary path for carriage of material upto site of work before quoting their rates. Nothing extra will be paid on this account. The approx. length of proposed road is 09.00 km**
4. General features & major components of the work area are as under:-

### Information & Instruction to Bidders

#### 1.0. **GENERAL:**

- 1.1. Letter of transmittal and forms for deciding eligibility are given in Section-III.
- 1.2. **All information called for in the enclosed forms should be furnished against the relevant columns in the forms. If for any reason, information is furnished on a separate sheet, this fact should be mentioned against the relevant column. Even if no information is to be provided in a column, a “nil” or “no such case” entry should be made in that column. If any particulars/query is not applicable in case of the bidder, it should be stated as “not applicable”. The bidders are cautioned that not giving complete information called for in the application forms or not giving it in clear terms or making any change in the prescribed forms or deliberately suppressing the information may result in the bid being summarily disqualified. Bids made by telegram or telex and those received late will not be entertained.**
- 1.3. The bid should be type written. The bidder should sign each page of application.
- 1.4. Overwriting should be avoided. Correction, if any, should be made by neatly crossing out initialing, dating and rewriting. Pages of the eligibility criteria document are numbered. Additional sheets, if any added by the contractor, should also be numbered by him. They should be submitted as a package with signed letter of transmittal.
- 1.5. References, information and certificates from the respective clients certifying suitability, technical knowledge or capability of the bidder should be signed by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent.
- 1.6. The bidder may furnish any additional information which he thinks is necessary to establish his capabilities to successfully complete the envisaged work. He is, however, advised not to furnish superfluous information. No information shall be entertained after uploading of eligibility criteria document unless it is called for by the Employer.
- 1.7. Any information furnished by the bidder found to be incorrect either immediately or at a later date, would render him liable to be debarred from tendering/taking up of work in CPWD. If such bidder happens to be enlisted contractor of any class in CPWD, his name shall also be removed from the approved list of contractors.

#### 2.0. **DEFINITIONS:**

- 2.1. In this document the following words and expressions have the meaning hereby assigned to them:

- 2.2. **EMPLOYER:** Means the President of India, acting through Executive Engineer, Border Fencing Division-V, CPWD, 79th BN, BSF Campus, Mundra road, Bhuj-370001 (Gujarat) or successor thereof.
- 2.3. **BIDDER:** Means the individual, proprietary firm, firm in partnership, limited company (private or public) or corporation.
- 2.4. “Year” means “Financial Year” unless stated otherwise.
- 2.5. “**BFZ**” means Border Fencing Zone.
- 2.6. “**BFD**” means Executive Engineer, Border Fencing Division-V, CPWD, 79th BN, BSF Campus, Mundra road, Bhuj- 370001 (Gujarat) or successor thereof.
- 2.7. “**BFLD**” means Border Flood Lighting Division, CPWD, 79th BN, BSF Campus, Mundra road, Bhuj- 370001 (Gujarat) or successor thereof.
- 2.8. “**CE, BFZ**” means Chief Engineer, Border Fencing Zone, CPWD, New Delhi or successor thereof.
- 2.9. “**CE BFLZ**” means Chief Engineer, Border Flood Lighting Zone, CPWD, New Delhi or successor thereof.
- 3.0. **METHOD OF SIGNING THE ELIGIBILITY BID:**
- 3.1. If the bidder is an individual, the application shall be signed by him above his full type written name and current address.
- 3.2. If the bidder is a proprietary firm, the application shall be signed by the proprietor above his full type written name and the full name of his firm with its current address.
- 3.3. If the bidder is a firm in partnership, the application shall be signed by all the partners of the firm above their full type written names and current address, or, alternatively, by a partner holding power of attorney for the firm. In the later case a certified copy of the power of attorney should **ALSO BE SCANNED AND UPLOADED TO THE E-TENDERING PORTAL**. In both cases a certified copy of the partnership deed and current address of all the partners of the firm should accompany the application.
- 3.4. If the bidder is a limited company or a corporation, the application shall be signed by a duly authorized person holding power of attorney for signing the application accompanied by a copy of the power of attorney. ## 5.0. PARTICULARS PROVISIONAL

The particulars of the work given are provisional. They are liable to change and must be considered only as advance information to assist the bidders.

## 6.0. SITE VISIT

The bidders are advised to visit the site of work, at his own cost, and examine it and its surroundings to himself collect all information that he considers necessary for proper assessment of the prospective assignment. **The work is to be executed in the border areas where zero tolerance on security norms are to be adhered in view of National Security. Neither any hindrance nor any additional cost on these grounds will be admissible to the agency.**

## 7.0. INITIAL CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

- 7.1. The bidder should have satisfactorily completed as mentioned below similar works during the last seven years ending **last date of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. *This is not applicable for CPWD registered contractors.***

**Three similar works of each costing not less than Rs.3124/- lacs.**

or

**Two similar works each costing not less than Rs.4686/-lacs.**

or

**One similar work costing not less than Rs.6248/- lacs.**

**(“Similar work shall mean road construction work i/c embankment & culvert work”)**

**Note-1:-** Components of work executed other than those included in definition of similar work shall be deducted while calculating cost of similar work. Bidder shall submit abstract of cost of work in support of this.

**Note-2:-** For the purpose, “Cost of work” shall mean gross value of the completed work including the cost of materials supplied by the Government/Client, but excluding those supplied free of cost. This should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer / Project Manager or equivalent.

**Note-3:-** The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of submission of bids.

- 7.2. The bidder should have had average annual financial turn over (gross) of **Rs.3905/-** lacs on Civil Construction works during the immediate last three consecutive financial years ending **31st March 2019**. This should be duly audited by a Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average.

- 7.5. Should have a bidding capacity equal to or more than **Rs.7810/- Lacs**. Further details if required may asked from the contractor after opening of technical/ eligibility bids.
- 7.6. The bidder should have sufficient number of Technical and Administrative employees for the proper execution of the contract. The bidder shall have to submit a list of these employees stating clearly how these would be involved in this work within 15 days of award of work.
- 7.7. It is mandatory to upload scanned copies of all the documents including GST registration as stipulated in the bid document. If such document is not uploaded his bid will become invalid and cost of bid document & processing fee shall not be refunded.
- 7.8. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Bid processing fee shall not be refunded if:
- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.

## 8.0. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Evaluation of the performance of contractors for eligibility shall be done by NIT approving authority or a committee constituted by him. All the eligible similar works executed and submitted by the bidders may be got inspected by a committee which may consists client or any other authority as decided by NIT approving authority. The marks for the quality shall be given based on this inspection, if inspection is carried out.

8.1. The details submitted by the bidders will be evaluated in the following manner.

8.1.1. The bidders qualifying the initial criteria for eligibility as prescribed in Para 7 above will first be scrutinized and the bidder's eligibility for the work be determined.

8.1.2. The bidders qualifying the criteria for eligibility as set out in Para 7.1 to 7.5 above will be evaluated for following criteria by scoring method on the basis of details furnished by them:-
